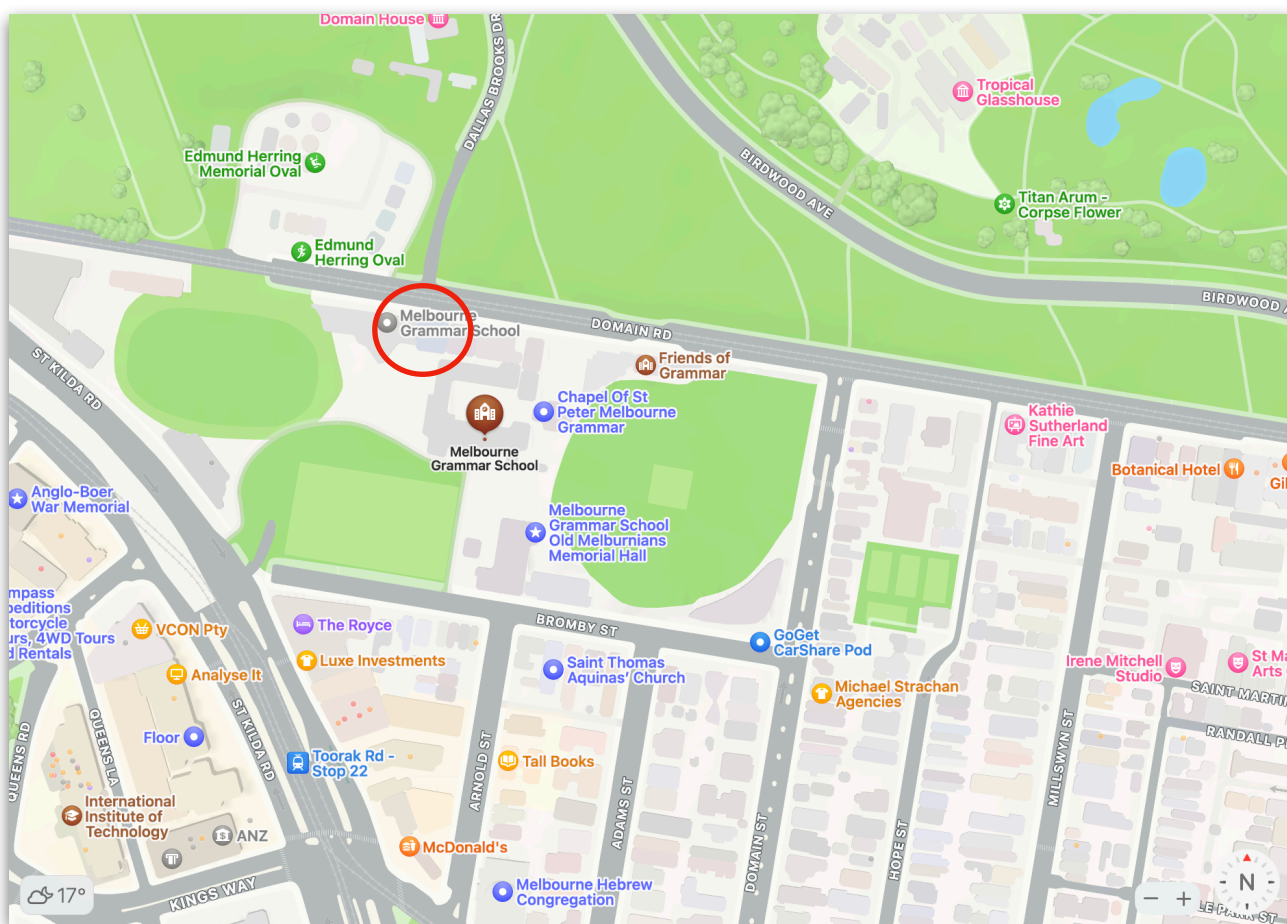
DETAILS
